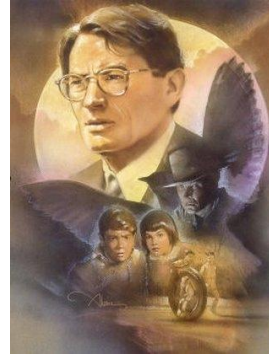
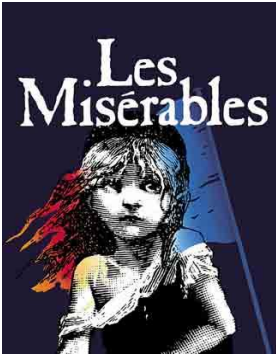

8th Grade Summer Shakespeare Festival Tour

2012



Date: July 10-11, 2012 (Tue.-Wed.)

Estimated Cost: Cost per participant is estimated to be not more than \$185/student or parent, including tickets to **three shows**—*Les Misérables*, *Mary Stuart*, and *To Kill a Mockingbird*—plus a backstage tour, lodging, transportation, and Wednesday morning breakfast and lunch.

Itinerary:

- Tuesday, July 10: Leave American Heritage School at 8:30 a.m. and arrive in Cedar City, Utah early afternoon (hotel check-in) and then proceed to the 2:00 p.m. performance of *Les Misérables* performed in the Randall Jones Theater. Dinner Tuesday evening will be near the festival grounds. Attend the "Green Show" on the Shakespearean festival grounds and proceed to the 8:00 p.m. performance of *Mary Stuart* at the outdoor Adams Shakespeare Theatre. Lodging in Cedar City that evening at the Comfort Inn and Suites.
- Wednesday, July 11: Breakfast buffet at the hotel. Shakespeare Back Stage Tour at SUU campus followed by a devotional and nature hike at Cedar Breaks National Park. Sack lunch provided. Attend 2:00 p.m. performance of *To Kill a Mockingbird*. Return home that evening, arriving at AHS at approximately 8:30 p.m.

Meals: Bring sack meals *or* money for lunch and dinner for Tuesday and dinner on Wednesday. A breakfast buffet is included on Wednesday morning and a sack lunch will be provided on Wednesday afternoon. Don't forget to eat a good breakfast on Tuesday before coming!

Lodging: Room rates are based on four people per room, sharing two queen beds. Parents who desire only two people per room will be charged the difference between the room prices.

Transportation: Transportation is included in the \$185 estimate *unless* we are unable to obtain volunteer parent drivers, in which case we will need to make a decision about alternative transportation methods, such as chartering a bus, which could increase the cost. Volunteer drivers will be reimbursed for fuel costs.

Dear Eighth Grade Parents,

PLEASE NOTE that we will be making block reservations on Thursday, March 1st for all participants who have submitted their registration form (attached) and payment. We will not obtain tickets for your child (or for you) until you have completed, signed and submitted the attached registration form with your payment. Once you have submitted your registration, the school will make advance non-refundable reservations for you and/or your child, estimated not to exceed \$185 per participant, and you will be responsible for payment regardless of whether you or your child ultimately are able to attend the tour
